

## FOSSILS FOUND IN HUGHENDEN & REGION

### Cretaceous Fossils

- Dinosaur - Pterosaur
- Pterosaur jaw fragment
- Minmi Paravertebra (90% complete specimen)
- Muttaborrasaurus langdoni
- 60% complete (basis of "Hughie")
- Skull and neck, some bits of body
- Vertebra and major limb elements of at least two individuals. Possibly a juvenile specimen.

### Sauropod

- Scapula
- Centrum (Partial vertebra)
- Cervical vertebra

### Marine Reptiles

- Notochelone costata - turtle, numerous specimens.
- Cratochelone - turtle, single specimen.
- Kronosaurus queenslandicus (Pliosaur)
- Woolungasaurus glendowerensis - several skull elements (Elasmosaur)
- Polycotyloid Pliosaur - unnamed (Marathon Pliosaur)
- Plesiosaurids – numerous though not identifiable as bones are scattered.
- Platypterygius Australis - Ichthyosaur many specimens

### Molluscs

- Pseudaricula anomala
